Dominique and Thetris both grew up in Miami as children of single mothers, watching them struggle with multiple jobs just trying to make ends meet and raise families. Dominique works at a medical center and Thetris is employed by a municipality in Broward. As a family, they love the outdoors – cycling, visiting nature preserves, and anything with animals. Friday game nights and Sunday family cookouts are stringently observed! The young family is currently in cramped subsidized housing where they have never felt at home due to frequent moves, so homeownership has been a priority for them. While the parents are very excited about not paying rent that goes to someone else’s pocket, and setting a solid foundation for the future, the children are all anxious to have space to decorate as they like, a yard to roam in and a larger kitchen for lots of cooking.

HOMELESS MINISTRY

Thank you!! You are truly doing God's work in feeding the homeless.

This **Saturday – April 2, 2022**, we are looking for donations of **PASTA** dinners (preferably large trays) to make into individual meals. The trays should be pasta, ground meat and tomato sauce topping. They should be made in a disposable container and covered only with aluminum foil.

The suggested recipe is as follows:

Pasta with meat sauce:

- 2 pounds ground beef, chicken or turkey;
- 2 – 24 oz jars spaghetti sauce.
- 2 packages of pasta;(not spaghetti or linguine)

Please bring it **in a disposable aluminum pan.**

(Preferably hot off the stove) □

We are in need of clothes and shoes for men, women and children, and 1/2 liter bottles of water. Sandwiches are welcome too!! **Sandwiches need to be individually wrapped in a sandwich size ziplock plastic bag for sanitary reasons.** For two (2) loaves of prepared sandwiches and 1- case of 24 ½ liter bottles we will award a maximum of 2 community hours with a maximum of 4 loaves of prepared sandwiches and 2 – 24 bottle cases of water for no additional community hours.

Community hours will only be awarded for one type of donation and only for a single donation regardless of how many items are donated. The student must be present to receive the community service hours.

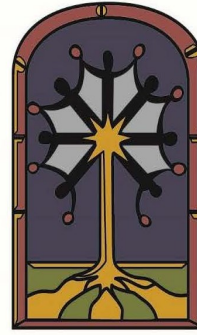
